Ron Giza stated he has been cited numerous times and there is a hearing in December. Mr. O'Malley was advised again to call 911 whenever there may be any issues.

Alejandro Veras with interpreter Dannie, approached the Supervisors about his residence at 8-8 ½ Oak Street, that Mr. Giza was not allowing him to work on his house and he had the Engineer there but was unable to work. Mr. Sperrazza stated that the Engineer deemed the structure a dangerous structure. Mr. Veras just kept repeating the same subject. Mr. Rovinski asked Mr. Veras if he had legal representation and the interpreter replied no. Mr. Rovinski advised Mr. Veras to obtain a lawyer. Mr. Linskey stated the property was being demolished.

Jim McLaughlin, Westminster Road spoke in concern for the health and safety of the resident having to deal with the burning. Mr. McLaughlin expressed concern over the price of the refuse & recycling rates. Mr. Linskey explained about the prices and what it would cost monthly and quarterly. Mr. Rovinski asked Mr. McLaughlin if he has a better solution.

Teresa Michaels, 9 Oak Street, asked Mr. Rovinski why he would tell Mr. Veras of 8-8 ½ Oak Street to get a lawyer.


